NAPD's Adult Day Programs provide structure and a creative learning environment for adults aged 18+. Our goal is to empower each client to reach their fullest potential. Our programs are designed to group clients with similar life skills and social development needs, fostering growth & mutual support for all participants. CCA's & AEC's programming hours are 9 AM - 2:30 PM



Center for Creative Achievements - CCA

CCA is a fun, active, social day program for adults 18+. We teach and encourage self-advocacy through our program's person-centered approach, helping clients create and achieve goals based on their individual needs and interests. We highlight the strengths and unique abilities of each individual, encouraging independence and creative expression for all. CCA offers a variety of motivating activities including yoga, arts & crafts, sports, music, health, hygiene, personal development, cooking, and much more. CCA maintains a staff:client ration of 1:6.



Adult Enrichment Center - AEC

Our Adult Enrichment Center provides quality caring and compassionate services to adults with disabilities. AEC engages our clients with activities that foster creative learning environments, stimulating activities, healthy movement, and community outings. This program primarily focuses on assisting clients with their day to day needs such as: ADL, (Activities of Daily Living), communication skills, and critical living skills as well as partaking in music, yoga, arts & crafts, sensory stimulation and our MOVE Program. AEC maintains a staff:client ratio of 1:3.

NAPD's Community Day Programs spend approx. 70% of each day out in the community at large exploring and learning under full supervision.



Community Day Program - CDP

CDP seizes the opportunity to teach, learn and grow while on community outings. We engage our clients with skills such as good hygiene, money management and interaction in social settings. CDP clients get to experience and attend events that they may not have otherwise had the opportunity to. CDP clients make fun memories with their peers and staff having fun learning while exploring our beautiful community. CDP's basic programming hours are 9 AM - 2:30 PM CDP maintains a staff:client ration of 1:3.



Socialization Enrichment & Educational Development for Young Adults - SYA

SYA provides a safe, comfortable and stimulating environment where adults ages 18-22 can learn socialization skills to help with the essential activities of daily living. Educational & socialization skills are enhanced through a wide variety of environmental experiences such as activities, outings, nature hikes, group discussions, volunteering and participating in local community events. SYA's basic programming hours are 2 PM - 5:30 PM SYA maintains a staff:client ration of 1:5.



Mobility Opportunities Via Education/Experience - MOVE

NAPD utilizes the MOVE philosophy throughout all of our Programs. MOVE is an individualized activity-based process using motivational activities to help the individual improve the mobility skills of sitting, standing, walking and transitioning leading to improved health, independence, dignity and increased inclusion for the client. MOVE is more than a Program, it is a way of life!



Transportation Breakfast Club aka TBC

NAPD's Transportation Breakfast Club is offered to fill the need for early morning supervision due to Parent or Provider early morning transportation related issues. TBC provides a safe, comfortable & stimulating environment where our Clients can gather prior to their day program starting. All TBC Clients will enjoy a healthy, nutritious breakfast to begin their day free of charge. If breakfast is indeed the most important meal of the day, they are off to a great start each day! TBC's programming hours are 6:30 AM - 9 AM
